Come and join us in part one of our surveillance film and discussion series!

Currently in Aotearoa/NZ the GCSB bill has disturbing implications for both individual privacy and civil liberties. It gives the state increased powers of surveillance that allow it to be increasingly intrusive and challenge freedom of speech. Beside the fact that it infringes on human rights there is also no evidence of necessity or effectiveness. This kind of activity has been a recent trend globally within the last decade.

The series will have three parts:

The first week we will focus on *moving beyond* the problem, and lay out a vision of where we want to go.

The second week we will focus on the *problem* and the challenges of reaching our end goal.

And finally we will focus on possible solutions to the issue and what action we can take .

We aim to create a space where anyone can come and openly discuss important issues that have an impact on our society. Through discussion we aim to find solutions to global problems , and afterwards turn our proposed solutions into action. We see this discussion as an opportunity for people to clarify their own ideas as well as present and be exposed to possible solutions.
